

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Village of Plainfield, Will County, Illinois, hereinafter referred to as the OWNER, will receive sealed bids for 2010 Sidewalk Hazard Removal by Sawcutting, until 10:30 a.m. local time on September 10, 2010 at the Village Clerk's office, 24001 W. Lockport Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544. All bids will be opened and read aloud at that time.

The proposed improvements include the removal of sidewalk hazards by Sawcutting, 700 Inch-Feet.

Copies of the contract plans and specifications are on file at and must be obtained from the Village of Plainfield Department of Public Works, 14400 Coil Plus Drive, Plainfield, Illinois 60544. Randall Jensen, Village of Plainfield Superintendent of Public Improvements, (815) 230-2030 will be the contact person for the Village of Plainfield. A nonrefundable plan deposit of \$25.00 will be required for each set of contract documents removed from the OWNER'S office.

The Contractor must be pre-qualified by the Illinois Department of Transportation for the type and amount of work to be performed unless approved prior to bidding by the Village of Plainfield. Also, the prospective bidder must provide evidence of completion of ten (10) similar sized projects in the last five years prior to the issuance of a proposal.

The successful bidder must comply with provisions of the Illinois statute entitled "Wages of Employees on Public Works", as amended.

The successful bidder or bidders will be required to furnish a satisfactory payment bond and performance bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract.

A certified check, bank draft, satisfactory bid bond, or cash, payable to the order of the OWNER in amount not less than five (5) percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject the bid of any non-responsive, non-responsible bidder, and waive any informality to the benefit of the OWNER.

Any bidder may withdraw his bid prior to the opening of the bids. No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the OWNER for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of bid opening.
