MINUTES – MEETING of SEPTEMBER 17, 2009

Commissioner Nott called the September 17, 2009 meeting of the Board of Police Commissioners to order at 7:01 p.m. In addition to Commissioner Nott, in attendance were Commissioners Greg Chapman and Raymond Brixey, Chief Don Bennett and recording secretary, Kathy Glavac.

The minutes of the May 21, 2009 meeting were read. There being no corrections or clarifications, Commissioner Nott moved the minutes be approved as read. Commissioner Chapman seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried. The minutes were approved as read.
