

## **ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

The Village of Plainfield, Will County, Illinois, hereinafter referred to as the OWNER, will receive sealed bids for the resurfacing of Illinois Route 126 through the Essington Road intersection, installation of an eastbound to northbound left turn lane and the installation of traffic signals at the Illinois Route 126/Essington Road intersection, until 10:00 a.m. local time on September 7, 2010 at the Village Clerk's office, 24001 W. Lockport Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544. All bids will be opened and read aloud at that time.

The proposed improvement includes (1) the removal and replacement of approximately 1650 feet of the Illinois Route 126 hot mix asphalt surface, (2) pavement widening for an eastbound to northbound left turn lane, (3) the installation of traffic signals, traffic control, pavement markings and other related items.

The contract documents, including plans and specifications, are on file at the Village Offices in the Village of Plainfield, Illinois and at the office of the ENGINEER. Greg Heiden, Village of Plainfield Transportation Engineer, (815) 230-2037 will be the contact person for the Village of Plainfield.

Copies of the contract plans and documents must be obtained from the ENGINEER, Hutchison Engineering, Inc., 605 Rollingwood Drive, Shorewood, Illinois 60404, telephone (815) 773-2233. A nonrefundable plan deposit of \$50.00 will be required for each set of contract documents removed from the ENGINEER'S office.

The Contractor must be pre-qualified by the Illinois Department of Transportation for the type and amount of work to be performed unless approved prior to bidding by the Village of Plainfield.

The successful bidder must comply with provisions of the Illinois statute entitled "Wages of Employees on Public Works", as amended.

The successful bidder or bidders will be required to furnish a satisfactory payment bond and performance bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract.

A certified check, bank draft, satisfactory bid bond, or cash, payable to the order of the OWNER in amount not less than five (5) percent of the bid shall be submitted with each bid.

The OWNER reserves the right to reject the bid of any non-responsive, non-responsive bidder, and waive any informality to the benefit of the OWNER.

Any bidder may withdraw his bid prior to the opening of the bids. No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the OWNER for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of bid opening.
