127th Street Road Closure

127th Street will be closed to all traffic, between Van Dyke Road and 248th Avenue, beginning April 2 and continuing through June 15, 2007. This closure is necessary for total road reconstruction.

The project includes asphalt work, striping, and the elimination of the deep ditch on the south side of 127th Street. Installation of storm sewer, curb, gutter, landscaped islands, turn lanes, streetlights, and a traffic signal at the intersection of 127th Street and Van Dyke Road are also part of the project.

After June 15, 127th Street will reopen to traffic and work will continue on Van Dyke Road to widen and install travel lanes and turn lanes. The completion date of the entire project is scheduled for November 2007.
