### ***Open House Scheduled***

Plainfield, IL -- The Village of Plainfield cordially invites all residents to attend the Open House for the 127<sup>th</sup> Street Lake Michigan Water Pumping Station and Ground Storage Facility on Saturday, June 9 between 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

The facility is located at 23201 W. 127<sup>th</sup> Street. However, due to limited on-site parking, arrangements have been made to utilize the parking lot at the Plainfield Park District's Eaton Preserve park site located on 135<sup>th</sup> Street, about ¼ mile east of Route 59. A shuttle bus will run between the sites every 15 minutes beginning at 11:00 a.m.

The 127<sup>th</sup> Street Lake Michigan Water Pumping Station and Ground Storage Tank were completed and put online in the fall of 2006. The station maintains water pressure and storage levels throughout the Village's water system while the ground storage tank can hold up to 5 million gallons of water and brings the system's total storage capacity to 9.25 million gallons.
