Lockport Street Detour Route

Plainfield, IL -- Beginning Monday, March 24, 2008, Lockport Street in downtown Plainfield will be closed to westbound traffic between James Street and Illinois Route 59. Alternate routes for westbound traffic include Illinois Route 126 (Main Street) and 143rd Street (newly designated as U.S. Route 30). Lockport Street will remain open to eastbound traffic and on-street parking will continue to be available on the south side of Lockport Street and on the adjacent side streets. In addition, parking is available in five off-street public parking lots located in the downtown. Pedestrian access will be maintained to businesses at all times.

The detour of westbound traffic is necessary to allow for the construction of a new water main, reconstruction of Lockport Street, and the construction of streetscape enhancements on Lockport Street between Route 126 (Main Street) and Route 59. The detour will be in place throughout construction which is scheduled for substantial completion by October 31, 2008.
