***Downtown Plainfield Pavement Preservation Project***

Plainfield, IL -- Lockport Street in Downtown Plainfield, from Route 59 to Route 126, will receive an application of a liquid asphaltic material in the next few weeks as part of a pavement preservation program.

The project consists of routing and filling cracks in the pavement, cleaning the surface, protecting the concrete/decorative surfaces, applying liquid asphalt preservation material, and then restriping the lanes. The crack filling operation will take place during the week under a flagging operation and should have minimal impact on motorists.

The bulk of the work will be the application of the liquid asphalt preservation material. This is scheduled to occur on a Sunday morning to have the least impact on the traveling public and businesses. We anticipate that this work will take approximately six hours and all lanes should be open by 12:00 p.m. During the application process, traffic and parking on Lockport Street will be restricted but through access at Des Plaines Street and Illinois Street will be maintained. The last step will be the restriping of the travel lanes and turn lanes.

This project is weather dependent; if inclement weather occurs, it will be delayed.
