2011 Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Street Improvement Program

Plainfield, IL -- Roadwork in the Walker's Grove, Nature's Crossing, and Century Trace Subdivisions will begin this month as part of the 2011 Motor Fuel Tax Street Improvement Program. The contractor will be performing concrete curb and sidewalk repairs, pavement grinding, and patching on selected streets. The final task will be to place the surface course and striping. Liquid asphalt priming material will be applied prior to paving operations and "Fresh Oil" signs will be placed at the various entrances into the subdivisions, please exercise caution when driving through these areas. Bus routes, garbage pickup, and mail delivery will be unaffected by this work but periodic lane closures are expected for some of the operations.

Similar street improvements are also scheduled to start in August on 135th Street (Wood Duck Drive to Essington Road), Renwick Road (Hometown Drive to Renwick Park Drive), Renwick Road (Peerless Drive to Route 30), and Fraser Road (River Road to Lewood Drive and Vintage Drive Intersection). Minor patching and resurfacing will also be completed on Spring Hill Drive and Illinois Street. Advance warning signs will be put up prior to the work commencing. All work is expected to be completed by the end of October.
