Northwest Riverwalk Community Input Meeting

The Village of Plainfield cordially invites the public to attend a Community Input Meeting on Tuesday, December 11, 2007 from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Village Hall, 24401 W. Lockport Street, in Downtown Plainfield. During the meeting, the public will have the opportunity to review the planned improvements for the Northwest Riverwalk that are part of the Plainfield Riverfront Master Plan. Following a brief presentation at 7:00 p.m., the project consultant and members of the Plainfield Riverfront Master Plan Steering Committee will be available to answer questions. The Northwest Riverwalk will be located on Village-owned property. The project area is generally located along the west bank of the DuPage River, north of Lockport Street, east of the EJ&E Railroad, and extending north to an imaginary line approximately 700 feet north of Lockport Street. The Village is seeking public comments on the preliminary design concepts prior to further design development and engineering.
