Plainfield IL – In an effort to further increase seat belt usage within the community, the Village of Plainfield and Plainfield Community Consolidated School District 202, along with sponsors First Community Bank of Plainfield and Plainfield Signs, are hosting a “buckle up” reminder sign design contest for the students of the four middle schools located within the Village of Plainfield: Indian Trail, John F. Kennedy, Richard Ira Jones, and Heritage Meadows.

What is a buckle up reminder sign? A buckle up reminder sign is a sign designed to remind students, parents, and faculty to fasten their seats belt before leaving school property, as the signs will be placed at the main exits of each middle school.

Students at each middle school are encouraged to participate in the design of the sign for their specific school, and sign designs must be done primarily in school colors, include the school name, or at least school initials, and the school mascot.

Graphic designs submitted by students will be replicated, produced, and donated by Plainfield Signs.

The student who submits the winning design at each school will receive a \$100 gift card to a store of their choice, donated by First Community Bank of Plainfield.

Applications for the sign design contest are now available for students to pick up in the main office of each school and are due by April 1, 2010.
