

Plainfield IL – The Plainfield Police Department made ten impaired driving arrests during the recent Labor Day impaired driving crackdown that ran from August 20th through September 6th. All ten of the impaired driving arrests were made after midnight. The crackdown also included a roadside safety check in conjunction with the Illinois State Police and the Will County Sheriff's Department.

The Plainfield Police Department joined with law enforcement agencies and highway safety partners throughout Illinois in this nationwide effort to save lives by getting impaired drivers off the roadways. This high visibility campaign featured a variety of outreach activities, which included paid advertising and nearly \$1.5 million in additional statewide police activity.

This Labor Day crackdown was funded by federal traffic safety funds through the Illinois Department of Transportation's Division of Traffic Safety as is part of the statewide "You Drink & Drive, You Lose" campaign.
