Plainfield, IL - On Thursday, September 23, 2010 at 12:49 p.m., the Plainfield Police Department responded to Chase Bank, located at 15115 South Illinois Street, reference a female attempting to cash a fraudulent check, which was later determined to be taken in a previously reported Burglary in the City of Chicago. Upon arrival, officers from the Plainfield Police Department subsequently conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle matching the description provided and began to conduct field interviews. As a result, the driver, Juana Noring Baez, 23 years of age, with a last known address of 1316 S.W. 4th Street in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, was arrested and transported to the Plainfield Police Department.

The Will County's States Attorneys Office approved the following charges for Baez:


- One (1) Count of Forgery, Class 3 Felony
- One (1) Count of Identity Theft, Class 4 Felony
- One (1) Count of Possession of Burglary Tools, Class 4 Felony

Baez was transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility and is awaiting her bond hearing.

Currently, detectives from the Plainfield Police Department are working with the United States Secret Service and other law enforcement agencies throughout the counties of Cook, DuPage, and Will, who are investigating similar criminal offenses.
