Plainfield IL – The Plainfield Police Department remains dedicated to reducing injury related and fatal traffic crashes. One of the best ways to do this is by aggressively enforcing occupant restraint laws.

The Plainfield Police Department will be conducting seat belt enforcement zones in conjunction with Halloween. In addition, Plainfield Police Officers will focus a large amount of their efforts on occupant restraint violations, and will take a “zero tolerance” approach. A part of the enforcement efforts will be funded through a grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation – Division of Traffic Safety.

Plainfield Police Officers will conduct enforcement both from their vehicles and on foot at various locations throughout the Village, and anyone stopped for failing to buckle up can expect a citation.
