The Plainfield Police Department takes a zero tolerance approach to occupant restraint violations. In addition, the Plainfield Police Department will be conducting several seat belt enforcement zones throughout the community during the holiday season.

Finally, please do not drink and drive. Always have a designated driver or arrange for alternative transportation, such as a taxi cab. The Plainfield Police Department will aggressively search for intoxicated drivers this holiday season. Remember, friends do not let friends drive drunk.
