4th of July Holiday Enforcement Planned

Plainfield IL – The Plainfield Police Department remains dedicated to reducing injury related and fatal traffic crashes. One of the best ways to do this is by aggressively enforcing occupant restraint laws and impaired driving laws.

The Plainfield Police Department will participate in a statewide click it or ticket and impaired driver campaign in conjunction with the 4th of July. This campaign will run from June 17th through July 4th.

During this timeframe, Plainfield Police Officers will focus a large amount of their enforcement efforts on occupant restraint violations and impaired drivers, and will take a “zero tolerance” approach. Plainfield Police Officers will conduct enforcement during daytime and nighttime hours, both from vehicles and on foot at various locations throughout the Village. Anyone stopped for failing to buckle up **WILL** receive a citation, and anyone driving impaired **WILL** be arrested.

Part of this enforcement is funded by a grant from the Illinois Department of Transportation Division of Traffic Safety, which places extra officers on the streets to conduct this target specific enforcement.

Let's all be safe as we celebrate this 4th of July; please remember to buckle up, every time, every trip and do not drink and drive!
