Residential Burglary

Plainfield, IL – On Sunday, June 12, 2011 at 7:57 p.m., the Plainfield Police Department responded to the 22800 block of Weinhold Drive in reference to a residential burglary.

Upon the arrival of the Plainfield Police, the victims advised when they arrived home, they observed a male black offender, familiar to the victims, fleeing their residence in a tan four door vehicle. Upon searching the residence, the victims observed numerous electronic equipment and bottles of alcohol missing. A short time later, Plainfield Police Officers, located the offenders and vehicle in the 24000 block of Champion Drive. Upon interviewing the offenders, they implicated themselves in the crime. Proceeds from the burglary were located inside the vehicle. The offenders were taken into custody and transported to the Plainfield Police Department for booking procedures. The offenders were later transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility and charged with one (1) count of Residential Burglary, a Class 1 Felony.
