Burglary from a Motor Vehicle Arrest

Plainfield, IL – On Friday, July 8, 2011 at 12:37 a.m., the Plainfield Police Department responded to the area of 143rd Street and Meadow Lane in reference to subjects trespassing into a vehicle.

Upon the arrival of the Plainfield Police, the victim advised they observed the offenders enter into their vehicle. The victim confronted the offenders, who fled the scene on bicycles. The victim followed the offenders and contacted the police. The Officers located the offenders a short time later and took them into custody. The offenders possessed bicycles, electronic equipment, and a credit card that did not belong to them. The offenders were transported to the Plainfield Police Department for questioning. The offenders implicated themselves in the crime. One of the offenders was processed and transported to the Will County Adult Detention Facility on charges of Burglary from a Motor Vehicle, Theft, Criminal Damage to Property and Possession of Stolen Property. The other offender, a juvenile, was released to a guardian with charges pending in juvenile court.

The offenders were described as the following:
