### Plainfield Police and Will County Sheriff's Department targeted non-valid drivers who drove to court

Plainfield IL – The Plainfield Police and the Will County Sheriff's Department conducted an operation to identify non-valid drivers who drove to their Will County Court date, Plainfield Branch location, on December 2nd.

Eight people scheduled for a court appearance were identified as having a non-valid driver's license. Undercover officers followed the non-valid drivers out of the courtroom and watched to see if they drove away. Uniformed officers waited outside in police vehicles to stop anyone identified by the undercover officers.

Out of the eight people identified, only one person drove himself to court. Francisco Valencia, 20, of Plainfield, was arrested for Driving While License Suspended for Driving Under the Influence.

The Plainfield Police and the Will County Sheriff's Department plan to conduct more operations on a regular basis to send a clear message and to deter non-valid drivers from getting behind the wheel.
