### For Immediate Release

Plainfield – Due to the impending Major Winter Storm that may impact the Plainfield area, the Village of Plainfield will be taking some proactive steps to assist in snow removal and emergency response.

- All on-street parking in the Village will be prohibited beginning at 10:00 p.m. on Monday, January 31, 2011 until 6: 00 a.m. on Friday, February 4, 2011.
- Indian Boundary Road between Renwick Road and County Line Road starting prior to 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 1<sup>st</sup> will be closed due to a past history of blowing and drifting snow conditions on this stretch of roadway during extreme snow events. It will remain closed until the storm has passed and the road has been cleared of snow.

The Plainfield Fire Protection District along with the Plainfield Police Department, Plainfield Public Works and the Plainfield Emergency Management Agency have been meeting to discuss contingency plans and response protocols, and will be adjusting staffing levels to facilitate better response parameters during this snow event. If the need arises, shelters will be available for motorists or those people directly impacted by the storm.

Everyone is reminded to monitor this impending winter storm through the National Weather Service and local media. Ensure you have the necessary supplies to last a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours, and if the storm does impact our area as expected, please avoid all unnecessary travel.
